Satisfaction of Completers

The EPP uses the Alumni Survey to collect data on graduates' perception of how well the EPP prepared them for their teaching area. The Alumni Survey asks alumni if they feel very well prepared, adequately prepared, barely prepared, or not at all prepared in six categories; content, pedagogy, diversity, assessment, technology, and professionalism. Due to COVID 19, the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 cohort data could not be collected. The 2021-2022 cohort answered 90% of the items on the survey as "Very Well Prepared."
