Health Insurance is **MANDATORY FOR ALL STUDENTS** - Students are required to "enroll/waive" the insurance coverage on-line each semester they attend. Students are **automatically charged EACH semester** for the student health insurance coverage when they register for 6 hours or more hours each semester. Students **MUST** complete the online waiver process and input/submit proof of comparable/equal insurance coverage to have the cost credited to their account **EACH semester before add/drop period ends**. If the student receives an approved waiver, the account will be credited at the end of the Add/Drop Period. (See the University Academic Calendar)

Books (estimated at \$1,000.00 each semester) and necessary fees, such as course fees (e.g. music, art, science & engineering labs), car registration, directed teaching, etc., must be determined on an individual basis and are not included above.
